Dear Congressman Cunningham:

As we have discussed, transportation is a significant issue affecting the quality of life for residents in north San Diego County and Western Riverside County. The lack of adequate infrastructure means residents must spend more time commuting in congested freeway lanes or narrower state routes that are often less safe. The extensions of SR-56 that will connect it to I-5 and I-15 will provide much needed relief and improved safety for residents in our districts.

The San Diego Council of Governments has adopted the "Mobility 2030 Transportation Plan for the San Diego Region" to improve regional transportation mobility. In addition, SANDAG, the San Diego City Council, the County Board of Supervisors and Caltrans have cooperated to ensure that the middle segment of SR-56 will be completed in July 2004 with state and local funding. Your efforts to secure federal funding will ensure that the connectors can be built adding the final pieces to this important project.

Thank you for your continued efforts to improve the quality of life for North County residents. I look forward to assisting you on securing this funding and other matters of importance to the residents of our districts.
